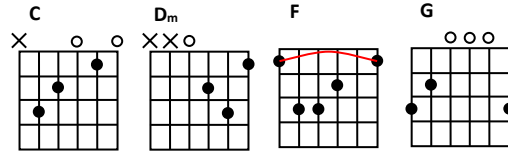


FOUR STRONG WINDS
