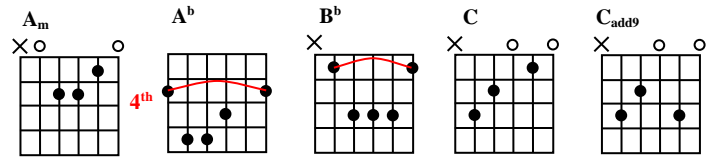

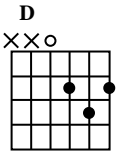


Intro C

Everybody's talking 'bout the new sound

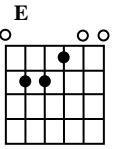
Bb **F**

Hot funny, cool punk, even if it's old junk

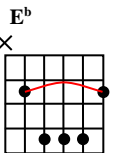
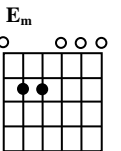
Bb **F**

Next phase, new wave, dance trace, anyways

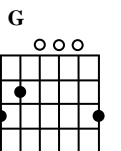
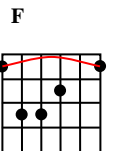
