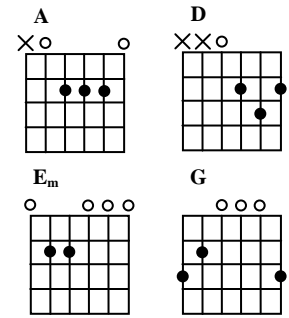


MR. TAMBOURINE MAN
