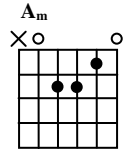

Prob'ly die in a small town

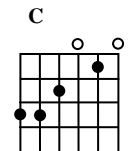

My job is so small town

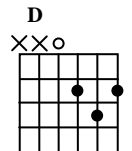

Used to daydream in that small town

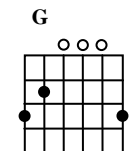
