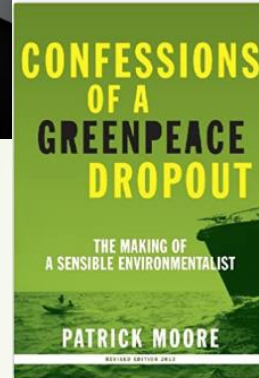


# OPS-30 Four Horsemen of the Green Apocalypse

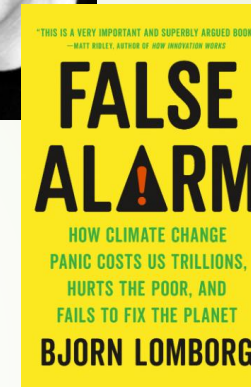
These are my opinions on these environmentalist's positions. I don't agree with all of their views but I would recommend their websites/books/documentary (highlighted below).

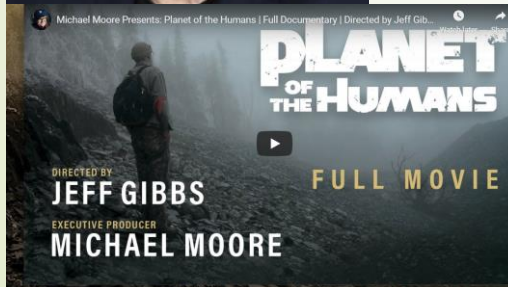


Bjorn Lomborg

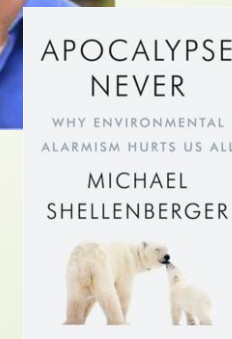
The sun, (not CO<sub>2</sub>) is the primary climate driver!
