God particle, CO<sub>2</sub>. Remember, from previous posts, to the right, Calgary's Airport temperatures have been

drastically "homogenized" (i.e.: manipulated). Measured temperatures have declined at a rate of 1.76 °C/century with homogenized rates rising at 1.35 °C/century since 1973 (manipulation of +3.11 °C/century). Maximum temperatures in Calgary are statistically flat since 1884 (+0.02 °C/century). Alberta is obviously localized but high

temperatures in the late 1800s and early 1900s were not that unusual (at least not in the measured data (what we experience), homogenized???).
