You taught me 'bout your past thinkin' your future was me

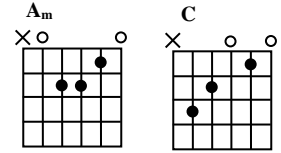
## **Verse 4**

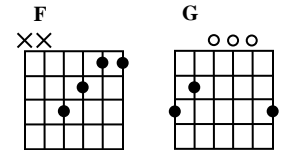
'Cause there we are again in the middle of the night We're dancing 'round the kitchen in the refrigerator light

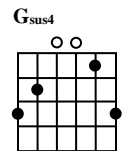
**Verse 5**
